Dear Parent/Caregiver,

The May holiday is just around the corner, we look forward to a few days of rest and relaxation. We had all hoped for more relaxation of the corona guidelines, but unfortunately, due to the high number of infections, not much is possible yet. For example, a red or orange travel advice from the national government applies to all countries. This means that traveling is not recommended, stay at home as much as possible. Only travel abroad if it is really necessary, for example due to a death in the immediate family.

As a school board, we would like to urge you to follow this advice: stay in the Netherlands. We see at some schools of Meer Primair that there are many corona infections, which means that an entire group has to be sent home. Teacher teams also have to contend with a lower staffing rate due to the high number of sick people. This does not benefit the quality of education. We therefore call on you to celebrate this May holiday in the Netherlands.


### **Home quarantine**

Children who do travel abroad must be quarantined for ten days upon their return. This way we prevent additional infections in the classroom. Unfortunately, we cannot provide home education during this period. The teacher teams in many of our schools are overloaded, teachers and support staff are on tiptoe. We do not want to burden them extra.

Parents, school and students have a common goal: to get corona underneath. That will only work if we stick to the guidelines. As a school board, we do everything we can to keep the number of infections as low as possible because we know that this is better for the continuous development and growth of our students. Safety for employees and students is our first priority. We therefore hope for your cooperation and understanding.

Finally, we wish you and your family a pleasant and well-deserved holiday. We hope for good weather and we look forward to seeing you healthy again after the holiday.
